The Butte County Historical Society was founded in 1956. We have an extensive archival program at our Archives/Museum in Oroville. We also operate several other historic sites in Butte County. We currently are developing our webpage (buttecountyhistory.com) to support a virtual learning experience that can be accessed anywhere in the world.



We are looking for volunteers for the following positions:

- Someone with QuickBooks experience to help with our financial management and work with the Finance Committee. The majority of the work can be done from home.
- Digitization volunteer to assist with our digitization program at the Archives for both the webpage and new acquisition photos for cataloging. Familiarity with Photoshop Elements or another photo editing program is helpful. The archives are open on Thursday and Friday from 9 to noon. Working one of those days would be very helpful. Training is available.
- Museum docent to help with new displays and work part time as one of our docents. The museum is open Fridays 9-12 and Saturdays 11-3 (we are closed in January, February and two weeks in December to the public). Training is available, (two positions open).
