



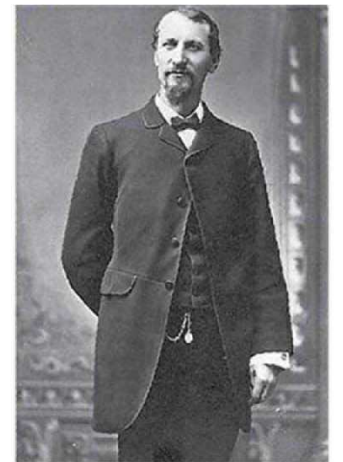

Who was Fred Harvey and who were the Harvey Girls? The Harvey House was an oasis of comfort and civilization along the railway routes of the Southwest. Entrepreneur Fred Harvey, dismayed by the often crude facilities he had seen at railway stops, provided clean and welcoming lunchrooms, restaurants and hotels until the 1940s.
