The Ehmann Home will be open for three guided tours of the downstairs on the day of the Olive Festival, June 17th. The tours are tentatively scheduled for 10 am, 11 am and 12 pm. After the Olive Festival the home will again be closed to the public as we move forward with our rehabilitation project. Our short term goal will be to improve the plumbing and electrical systems in the downstairs portion of the building to allow for regular openings and events. Long term, we will be fundraising to complete the repair or replacement of numerous windows, mitigation of dry rot and termite damage and improvement of the electrical and plumbing system for the entire house.

There will be an information table available at the Olive Festival to provide further information on this project.
