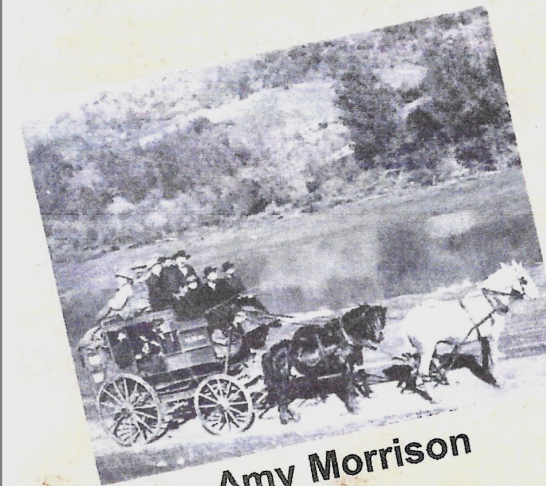

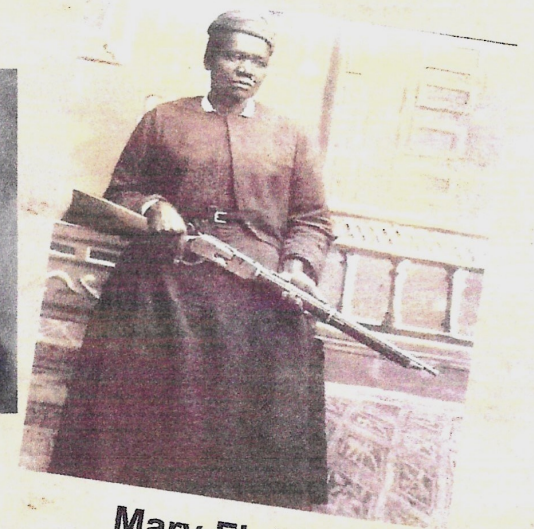

Children are invited to make holiday crafts. Volunteers will be assisting with the creation of cornhusk dolls, rope wreaths, and other frontier era crafts. All supplies will be provided.

Once again we will be reading a holiday themed story at 2 PM. Immediately after the story, there will be drawings for this year's quilts in addition to special items. These include a Barbie set with a pet spa, a remote control car, a Lego set and items of interest to adults.
