Join us at the Museum on Saturday, May 18th to view a new exhibit of paintings showing many of Butte County's historic spots. All of the art works are from the BCHS collection. The exhibit will be enhanced with photos of the locations, information about the locales depicted, and brief biographies of the artists. Artists represented include Carol Franklin, Lois Corbaley, and Hilda Winchester, among others. You will be able to compare the vision of different artists who painted the same local icon: the Bidwell Bar Suspension Bridge, the old County Courthouse, and the Bangor Church. If you can't make it on the 18th, the exhibit will remain up for several weeks. The Museum is open on Saturdays from 11-3, and can be accessed on Friday mornings by coming to the Archives next door. We hope to see you there.
